### *Blessing of the New Fire*

#### COLLECTS

**O** GOD, who through thy Son, the true corner-stone, hast bestowed upon thy faithful people the fire of thy brightness: sanc+tify this new fire, now struck from the flint-stone, to be profitable to our service: and grant unto us that by this paschal feast we may be so inflamed with heavenly desires; that we may with pure hearts attain unto the feast of thy eternal brightness. Through the same Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

**O** LORD God, Father almighty, who art light unailing, and the author of all lights: bl+ess this light which hath here been sanctified and blessed by thee, who hast enlightened the whole world: that we may be enkindled by that light, and enlightened with the fire of thy brightness: and like as thou didst enlighten Moses going forth from Egypt, so do thou enlighten our hearts and understandings; that we may be found worthy to attain unto life and light everlasting. Through Christ our Lord. *Amen.*

**O** LORD holy, Father almighty, everlasting God: vouchsafe to assist us who bless this fire in thy name, and in the name of thy only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ, our God and Lord, and of the Holy Ghost; and assist us against the fiery darts of the enemy, and enlighten us with thy heavenly grace: Who livest and reignest. *Amen.*
